



Grievance Policy

The Housing Development Corporation of Rock Hill, hereby known as HDC, receives funding from varying sources, including but not limited to private donors, non-profits, as well as local, state, and federal grants. Each funding source has the right to outline eligibility and/or program guidelines that shape the way funding is disbursed. If you have applied to receive funding through HDC you may be subject to eligibility criteria and program guidelines.

Submitting an application does not guarantee funds will be awarded. If your application to receive funds has been denied, you have the right to make a formal appeal. Appeals must be made in writing to the HDC director. Appeals must be delivered in a timely manner to the HDC Director from the date of original application denial. Verbal appeals will not be reconsidered. Appeals sent in more than 60 days after original application denial will not be reconsidered. This grievance policy will be posted in a public place at the HDC office as well as the HDC website at HDCRH.org. Anyone can request a copy of the grievance policy at any time.
